What New Heights Church Believes

1. The Authority of Scripture We believe the Bible is God's inspired, infallible Word and the ultimate authority for faith and practice.

2. The Triune God We believe in one God who exists eternally in three co-equal persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

- **God the Father** – Creator and ruler of the universe.
- **God the Son (Jesus Christ)** – Fully God and fully man, who died for our sins, rose bodily, ascended to heaven, and will return.

- **God the Holy Spirit** – Convicts of sin, indwells believers, empowers holy living, and gives spiritual gifts.

3. Humanity and Sin All people are created in God’s image with dignity and worth, yet every person has sinned and falls short of God’s glory.

4. Salvation by Grace Alone through Faith Alone in Christ Alone Salvation is a gift received by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone — not by works.

5. The Priesthood of All Believers Every believer has direct access to God through Christ and is called to minister. The Holy Spirit equips us with gifts to build up the church.

6. The Church and Its Mission The church is the body of Christ, called to love God, love others, make disciples, and proclaim the Gospel.

What We Believe About Our Worship Team

We are not just musicians — we are worship leaders. Every person on the team, regardless of role, leads worship by pointing people to the goodness of God and creating space for the congregation to respond in corporate worship.

Core Values of Our Team:

- **We REPRESENT the Church** We are church leaders. People will look to us as representatives of New Heights both inside and outside the church. We therefore hold ourselves to a higher standard.
- **We PREPARE to Lead Worship** We show up ready. This includes personal practice at home, attending Thursday rehearsals, and striving for excellence on Sundays.
- **We STRIVE to Be Teachable** We welcome feedback and correction. We are committed to growing together as a team.
- **We SERVE Others** We lead by serving. Our decisions — including song choices — are made with the good of the church in mind.
- **We Are a Family** We are brothers and sisters in Christ. We commit to working through conflict and loving one another for the benefit of the church.

Responsibilities and Expectations

- **Communication & Scheduling** All scheduling is done through the Church Center app and text. Schedule requests must be submitted in advance. We send schedules at least 3 weeks ahead.

- **Rehearsals** Weekly Thursday rehearsals are required if you are scheduled to serve on Sunday. Rehearsal is for putting parts together — not for learning songs from scratch.
- **Church Attendance** We expect all team members to be regular attenders of New Heights Church and participate in services.
- **Additional Opportunities** Team members may be asked to serve in youth services, special events, or other worship settings.

Code of Conduct

As worship leaders, we are held to a higher standard of conduct because we represent Jesus and New Heights Church at all times.

New Heights Church expects all leaders to:

- Maintain a growing personal relationship with Jesus through regular Bible reading and prayer.
- Live with integrity in all areas of life — including speech, relationships, and personal conduct.
- Speak and act in ways that honor God and build up others.

Conflict Resolution: We address conflict quickly and biblically.

1. Go directly to the person in private.
2. If unresolved, bring it to leadership. We prioritize unity and what is best for the church.

Social Media: Please remember that people from the church may view your posts. Avoid airing team conflicts, divisive topics, or anything that could damage your witness or the church's reputation.
